

SPEED TALK PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR 3 MINUTE SPEED TALK

Purpose

Speed talks provide an opportunity to present your research in an interesting way to raise awareness and understanding of the science underpinning the Banana Industry. The audience is predominantly growers and other stakeholders rather than your scientific peers, so the idea is not to dumb down your research, but to extract key messages from your research activity and connect your topic to the real world.

Format

Speed talks will be 3 minutes in duration with an allowance of 1 PowerPoint slide only.

Tips and tricks

Speed talks can have a high impact so it is important to prepare carefully. There are extensive resources available on the web on how to prepare successful short presentations to the intelligent non-technical audience.
