

ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR 1 MINUTE ORAL PRESENTATION (Banana Congress)

Purpose

One-minute oral presentations provide an opportunity to **pitch** the research you are presenting in your poster in an interesting way to raise awareness and understanding of the science underpinning the banana industry. It is also an opportunity for the industry to see who you are. The **audience is predominantly growers and other stakeholders** rather than your scientific peers, so it is important to extract key messages from your research activity and connect your topic to the real world.

Format

1 minute in duration and speakers should prepare **1 slide only** to present during the **main Congress program**.

Tips and tricks

One-minute talks can have a high impact, so it is important to prepare carefully. **This is your opportunity to attract the greater industry to find out more about your research at your poster. The pitches can be regarded as an icebreaker or an enabler of conversations which may happen throughout the Congress.** There are extensive resources available on the web on how to prepare successful short presentations to the intelligent non-technical audience.

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR 10 MINUTE ORAL PRESENTATION (Sci Symposium)

Purpose

Presentations provide an opportunity to present your research in an interesting way to raise awareness and understanding of the science underpinning the banana industry. **The audience is predominantly researchers across a range of disciplines however other stakeholders and some growers** may also attend. The idea is to extract key messages from your research activity and connect your topic to the real world.

Format

10-minute presentation plus Q&A at the end of each theme to be presented during the **one-day Science Symposium**.

Tips and tricks

Oral presentations can have a high impact so it is important to prepare carefully and be mindful that the audience may not be experts in your discipline. There are extensive resources available on the web on how to prepare successful short presentations to the intelligent non-technical audience.
